# JOB DESCRIPTION

# AUTHORITY

Under the general supervision of the principal or designee, and under the specific direction of the Band Director, provide specific instruction and direction to the Color Guard/Drill Team.

## **KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES**

The Color Guard/Drill Team Coach should be well versed in the unique aspects of directing a Band Color Guard/Drill Team. The Color Guard/Drill Team Coach is expected to assist the Band director in developing and preparing the Band Color Guard/Drill Team for performances and competitions, and to assist in the coordination of band performances and competitions

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Must have extensive experience in participating in a competitive Color Guard/Drill Team. Must be able to work with others to promote a healthy learning environment where the students will be able to reach their fullest potential.

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES** (dependent upon site, some duties may not pertain)

- As a director of learning:
- Teach skills in dance, flag and rifle technique
- Instruct pupils in citizenship, basic communicative skills, and other general elements of the course of study common to all teachers as specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedures of the school district.
- Work with the band director to plan a balanced color guard program and organize daily rehearsal time so that preparation, rehearsal, and instruction can be accomplished within the allotted time in after school rehearsals.
- Provide individual and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each pupil.
- Encourage pupils to develop individual dance skills to the greatest extent possible
- Utilize repertoire of all types of music literature, including traditional and contemporary, that are appropriate for the ages and skill levels of the students
- Maintain surveillance over school owned equipment and uniforms to prevent loss or abuse
- Make minor adjustments and repair as needed.
- Establish and maintain standards of pupil behavior needed to provide an orderly, and productive environment during individual practice, group rehearsals, and color guard performances
- Work with the band director to plan and organize school and community music events, such as concerts and competitions throughout the area.
- With the help of the band director differentiate instruction to accommodate the needs of the student populations represented in the ensemble including ESL, special education, and gifted.
- Plan, rehearse and direct pupils in musical programs for school and community.
- Must be available after school hours to rehearse the color guard.

- Previous Color guard/drill team experience.
- Knowledge of the appropriate California Standards and Frameworks.
- Effective interpersonal, effective communication skills.
- Effective organizational skills.

- If conducting classes, hold a current California Teaching Credential and be Highly Qualified under the provisions of the No Child Left Behind act.
- Be able to work outside school hours as required.
- Be reviewed and evaluated for performance of the duties and responsibilities annually by the principal or designee.
- Maintain a log of hours devoted to the duties of the position.
