SUMMARY OF VISIT

- ► Sunday, March 26th- Wednesday, March 29th
 - ► Inclusion of all stakeholders
- Visiting Committee requested meetings with District Administration, Board Members, parents, students, and all FHS staff over the course of the visit.
 - Meetings were completed with VC and specific groups.
- ► Focus Groups were set aside to review various sections of the WASC Report.

AREAS OF STRENGTH

- ► Farmersville is a clean, well-maintained campus where relationships are valued, as evidenced by the positive rapport between students and staff who readily support one another.
- Abundant resources are provided by FHS and FUSD to support student growth and achievement through professional development and program support.
- ► There are a wide variety of CTE pathways and electives offered that are placed on the master schedule based on student voice and choice.
- Staff demonstrates a willingness to increase capacity for instructional techniques through professional development and PLC collaboration.

AREAS OF GROWTH & ACTION PLAN

- There needs to be fidelity to the WASC process where meetings occur and programs are analyzed continuously between cycles.
 - > WASC VC identified Growth Areas will be reviewed during staff meeting.
 - > WASC Leadership team will have PD through the WASC Resources Website.
 - > Training for staff on writing conventions for focus group program assessment
- ▶ There is a need to update the SLOs with the input of all stakeholders to provide specific, measurable outcomes towards student achievement.
 - Creation of rubric
 - Review of rubric by stakeholder groups
 - > Training of student in self-evaluation process
 - Creation of progress monitoring tools

AREAS OF GROWTH & ACTION PLAN

- ► There is a need to improve data analysis processes in order to improve student outcomes and direct professional development efforts.
 - > Improved district orientation for new staff
 - Communication between site and district regarding what new staff training will be performed by which facility
 - Vertical alignment with feeder schools including common PLC, planning time, training, and pacing alignment
- ▶ There is a need to develop improved DOK levels throughout units of instruction and strategies for differentiating instruction to support all students' needs.
 - Intentional Lesson Planning and submission
 - Continual Improvement PLC strategy
 - Hire 3 EL Instructional Aides for ELD and core classes
 - ► Hire 1 Special Education Instructional Aide
 - Develop placement rubric for ELD students
 - Provide common planning time for ELD and core area teachers to align pacing sequence for all courses

STATUS & NEXT STEPS

- ► The decision of the Commission was to grant Probationary Accreditation Status through June 30, 2025 with a two-day visit in the 2024-2025 school year. Accreditation still stands during Probationary period.
- ► Farmersville High School is required to prepare an in-depth progress report for the Probationary Visit.
 - ▶ The report and visit should demonstrate that the school has:
 - Addressed the growth areas for continuous improvement through the schoolwide action plan
 - 2. Made appropriate progress on the implementation of the schoolwide action plan
 - 3. Improved student achievement relative to the schoolwide learner outcomes and the academic standards.
